## Joint EURISOL-EURONS Town Meeting: Final Announcement

The EURISOL Design Study and EURONS projects -- supported by the European Commission under Framework Programme 6 -- will hold a joint Town Meeting in Helsinki, Finland, from September 17 to 19, 2007, hosted by the University of Jyväskylä and the Helsinki Institute of Physics. September 20 and 21 will be devoted to various EURISOL and EURONS committee meetings. It will be an opportunity to exchange ideas and information on R&D progress between participants of EURONS and EURISOL as well as the community at large. This meeting will also provide a bottom-up forum for discussing the future activities in nuclear structure physics in Europe. This will be an opportunity for presentation of the letters of intent for Networks and Joint Research activities.

**Venue:** The venue will be the Dipoli Congress Centre on the Otaniemi campus of the Helsinki University of Technology, in the City of Espoo, on the outskirts of Helsinki. The meeting will start with three open combined EURISOL & EURONS Town Meeting days (17-19 September), with invited and contributed presentations on the first two days. The third day (Wednesday, 19 September) will be devoted to open sessions on "Future activities in Nuclear Structure Physics in Europe" and news from NuPECC. On Thursday and Friday a number of EURISOL and EURONS committee meetings will take place, and some EURISOL Task meetings will also be held.

**Invited presentations** will relate to the EURISOL Design Study, or to existing JRAs, networks or Trans-National Access within EURONS. Other – contributed – presentations will all be in the form of posters.

**Note:** Oral presentations on Wednesday of Letters of Intent for possible future proposals, for open discussion, will be by invitation only, subject to a selection process based on advice from a NuPECC study group.

**Financial Support:** Students or Post-docs whose contributions were accepted could also apply for partial financial support, via their registration forms. Support will consist of partial reimbursement, against receipts, tickets, boarding passes, etc., for reasonable subsistence and travel costs. The amount of financial support available is €700 per person (maximum). All requests for financial support have now been considered and those approved have been informed by e-mail, and the claim forms have been sent to them.
