



The Department of Physics at the Technische Universität Darmstadt has an opening for an

Associate Professor (W2) in "Theoretical Nuclear Physics"

in collaboration with the Helmholtz ExtreMe Matter Institute (EMMI), starting as soon as possible. The EMMI W2 Professorship is also part of the new Theory Center at the Institut für Kernphysik.

EMMI is a new research institute set up at GSI, Darmstadt, in the framework of the international Helmholtz Alliance "Cosmic Matter in the Laboratory". EMMI embraces 14 internationally renowned academic partners and constitutes a research infrastructure for forefront interdisciplinary theoretical and experimental research on matter under extreme conditions, ranging from strongly interacting matter in the early universe, plasma physics, neutron matter and neutron-rich systems, atomic physics and strong electromagnetic fields to ultracold quantum gases.

To support and strengthen the EMMI activities at the TU Darmstadt and to contribute to teaching theoretical physics in the Department of Physics, we are looking for an outstanding individual with expertise in the theory of strongly interacting many-body systems with focus on extreme conditions.

The position is tenured with a remuneration package commensurate with experience and qualifications, following the German "W-Besoldung". The regulations for employment are specified under §§ 61 and 62 HHG (Hessisches Hochschulgesetz).

The Technische Universität Darmstadt intends to increase the number of female faculty members and encourages female candidates to apply. In case of equal qualifications severely disabled applicants will be given preference.
